## Additional notes:

### Web page citation

Author, A. (date). Title of document [Format description if unusual]. Retrieved from <https://URL>

### Lecture notes

(First Initial of person who gave the lecture. Second Initial if known. Last Name, personal communication, Month Day, Year lecture took place)

Example in body of my text:

There are a variety of coral reef types in the Hawaiian Islands (J. Marcoux, personal communication, April 15, 2018).

In APA style, your notes from a lecture fall into the “Personal Communication” category. As such, they are only mentioned in the body of your text, not in the References section. Mention the source in parentheses right after a quote or paraphrase of content from your lecture notes.

Don’t put the person’s name in your citation if you already mentioned their name in your sentence.

### Video citation

Author, A. A. [Screen name]. (year, month day). *Title of video*
